Upward Bound is a federally funded program from the US Department of Education to encourage first-generation, limited-income students to further their education. UB services help students explore college and career opportunities, preparing them to enter the college of their choice upon graduation from high school. Upward Bound students attend a daily class where they will be provided with information about college, careers, study skills, financial aid, and participate in field trips. This rigorous class will provides academic college prep activities in math, science, literature, and other disciplines to ensure students are well prepared for college. Upward Bound students also attend a six week residential summer program on the Boise State University campus. **All Upward Bound services are free.**
